
INSURANCE OPEN ENROLLMENT IS JUST AROUND THE CORNER!

In the past, finding affordable health insurance was challenging, but there's finally good news! Through the work of our county leaders, there are more affordable plans for 2020. Here's what you need to know:

- Open enrollment: November 1 January 15, 2020 for plans beginning on January 1, 2020.
- The FIRC (Family Intercultural Resource Center) has a team of official Health Navigators and can help you





find the plan(s) that are right for you and your family.

• You can also find information and sign up via <u>Connect for Health Colorado</u>, the state's health insurance marketplace.

Make sure you check out the new insurance rates and find out if you qualify for tax credits and subsidies.

And don't forget, the Care Clinic accepts insurance, Medicare, Medicaid and CHP+ and we offer services for the unisured.
