

Summit Community Care Clinic services update

As a patient of <u>Summit Community Care Clinic</u>, you may contact your provider via the <u>patient portal</u>

The situation regarding COVID-19 continues to evolve. Therefore, we are making a few changes to our scheduling process and our services to keep our patients, community and healthcare staff healthy. Here's what to expect:

When you call the clinic for an appointment, we will ask you questions about the nature of your visit to determine the best care for you. We may also give you the option of a telehealth visit. For all scheduled appointments, patients will be greeted outside the front door of our main clinic. Our greeter will ask you questions and then give you further directions. We ask that only essential family members accompany a patient. Also, if you are a current patient, you may reach out to us via the patient portal.

All non-emergency dental appointments will be rescheduled effective immediately until further notice. Our dental staff will be reaching out to patients who have upcoming scheduled visits. For our behavioral health services, we are modifying our visits to provide telehealth visits. Our School Based Health Centers will be closed until further notice.

We sincerely thank you for your patience and understanding during this time and we want to assure you that we are dedicated to keeping our patients, healthcare providers and community healthy!
